B.Sc. Nursing

M.Sc. Nursing (Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care)

Eligibility Criteria

A minimum of 45% aggregate marks in Intermediate or 12th examination from a recognized central / state boards or its equivalent in 2020, 2021, 2022 academic years with Biology, Physics, Chemistry & English as subjects.

M.Sc. Nursing (Nurse Practitioner in Critical Care)

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must possess a registered B.Sc. Nurse with a minimum of one-year clinica experience, in any critical care unit.
- Must have undergone the B.Sc. Nursing in an Institution recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.
- Must have scored not less than 55% aggregate marks in the B.Sc. (N) program.
 Pass in qualifying examination from a recognized central / state University or its equivalent and also rank obtained in GAT (Nursing PG) 2022.

VENTURE DEVELOPMENT CENTRE (INNOVATION CELL)
